 - **Dipl. Ing. Dr. h.c. Josef Riegler**, Austria, President of the Ecosocial Forum of Europe. Topic: "The Global Marshall Plan for a world-wide Eco Social Market Economy - A European Initiative".
 - **Eng. Ali Ahmed Sayed**, Counselor to the Minister of Education from Egypt for International Cooperation and Director of Mubarak-Kohl Initiative. Topic: "The Role of VET in Poverty Reduction ; Lessons learned: Introduction of cooperative training (Dual System) as part of VET reform in Egypt in cooperation with the Federal Republic of Germany".
